Introduction

Welcome to the Alphacap Spring 2011 edition.

IMPORTANT NOTE

The Alphacap Spring 2011 edition is required to ensure that the Alphacap software is in line with the latest Alphatax Enterprise Edition (Spring 2011).

Installation

The upgrade is in two steps:

- Installing Alphacap on each user's workstation
- Updating the Alphacap database

Installing Alphacap

To install the new edition of Alphacap, insert the Installation CD and press the enter key at the prompts. This will overwrite previous versions of Alphacap. If the database is not updated (see overleaf), an error message will be displayed when you open Alphacap.

Updating the Alphacap database

IMPORTANT NOTE

The Alphatax database must have been updated to version 23 (Spring 2011 Edition) BEFORE you update the Alphacap database. For details, refer to the Alphatax UK Spring 2011 Release Notes.

To update the Alphacap database, open Enterprise Manager and:

1. Double-click the **System Administration** item in the Contents tree.
2. Double-click the **Update Alphacap Database** item.
3. Connect to the database for SQL Server or Oracle as appropriate.

The **Database** drop-down list is a list of all the Alphacap databases on the selected server. The corresponding **Status** gives the version number of the database. For Spring 2011, the version number is 11. You **must** apply the upgrade if the Status shows a version number earlier than 11.

4. Choose **Upgrade Now** for Enterprise Manager to upgrade the database. (For further details refer the Enterprise Manager Administrator Guide which is located in the Manuals folder on the installation CD.)

Note. You only need to update the Alphacap database once for your organisation.
